INFORMATION & INSTRUCTIONS

1. ADMISSION

- i. Admission of the Selected candidate for B.Sc. Medical Imaging Technology (MIT) course will be held from **3rd – 8th July 2023**.

Reporting Time for Admission: 9.00 am.

Venue: Admissions' Office, Ground floor, St. John's Medical College

ii. **Admission protocol:**

Step 1: Selected candidates shall report to the **ADMISSIONS' OFFICE**, Ground Floor, St. John's Medical College at 9.00 am, give an acceptance letter, and obtain the **ADMIT SLIP**.

Step 2: Proceed to the **ACADEMIC SECTION** and submit the Admit Slip to complete the admission process.

- iii. Candidates shall ensure that all the original documents required are handed over to the Academic Section.
- a. 10th Standard Marks Card
 - b. 12th Standard Marks Card
 - c. Diploma Course Marks Card (For Lateral Entry candidates only)
 - d. For Catholic candidates only: Baptism certificate and/or a letter from Parish Priest stating that the candidate is a *bona fide* member of the parish
 - e. SC/ST/OBC Certificate for applicable candidates
 - f. Transfer Certificate
 - g. Migration Certificate
 - h. Eligibility Certificate (Refer below for details)

Eligibility Certificate (to be procured before the Admission Process)

Soon after the announcement of results, the candidates are required to apply online (www.rguhs.ac.in) for the **Eligibility Certificate** to Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences (RGUHS), Karnataka, and submit the same to the Academic Section as soon as possible.

Failure to produce the Original documents as required by the Academic Section within the stipulated time and without the written permission of the Director, will be considered **NON-ACCEPTANCE** of selection, and the seat will be allotted to the **WAIT-LISTED** candidates.

- iv. After the completion of the Academic Section procedures, the candidates shall proceed to the fee payment counter at the Accounts Section for the payment of fees.
- v. The candidate shall pay the fees by 4.00 pm on the day of admission. Any candidate failing to pay the fees by 4.00 pm on the day of the admission will forfeit the seat.



- vi. The candidates are then required to meet the Director, the Dean and the Associate Director – College, in their respective offices for their approval.
- vii. The admission granted is considered “**PROVISIONAL**” until all the original supporting documents submitted are approved by the RGUHS, Karnataka.

2. HOSTEL ACCOMMODATION: (Subject to availability)

Candidates requiring hostel accommodation on Campus should apply to the Associate Director, St. John’s Medical College, during the office hours on **the day of the admission**.

Candidates who have obtained hostel accommodation are required to occupy their hostel rooms by **4:00 pm on the day prior to commencement of classes, the date of which will be intimated later.**
