

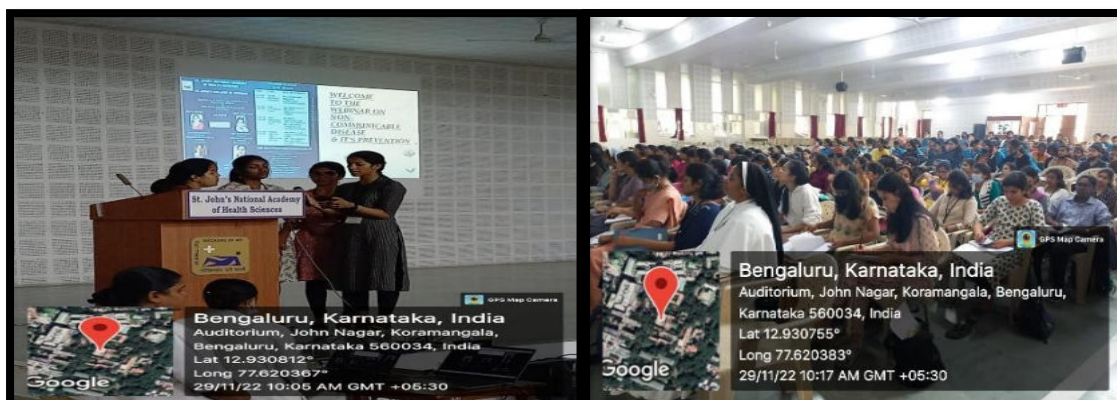

1. MORBIDITY CLINIC

2.WEBINAR





A webinar on Non-Communicable Diseases and its prevention was organised by the department of Community Health Nursing on 29th November 2022 from 10 am to 12 Noon. The Topic was introduced and the theme opening was done by Dr.Lakshamma V.T Principal, Kempegowda College of Nursing, Bangalore. Mrs.Deepa.S.Nair, Associate Professor & HOD of CHN Dept, SJCON, Mrs. Shofia Rani R, Principal of Viswa Sai College of Nursing, Dr. Shiji PJ Professor and HOD of Community Health Nursing, Father Muller, College of Nursing, Mangalore were the resource persons. 278 people attended the webinar 101 online and 178 offline including Faculty and students from Kempe Gowda College of Nursing, Viswa Sai College of Nursing, Father Muller College of Nursing and St. John’s College of Nursing.
