1. GROUP HEALTH EDUCATION AND NUTRITION DEMONSTRATION



Group health education and Nutrition demonstration was conducted in Maralkunte Village from 21st February to 26th February 2022 by the 4th year Bsc Nursing Students.

1. PULSE POLIO PROGRAMME



Pulse polio programme was observed from February 27th to March 2nd 2022. Students of St. John's College of Nursing was posted under 5 PHC Madiwala, Tavarakere, Adugodi UPHC, Adugodi Dispensary and Koramangala. Total of 2151 students were vaccinated in Madiwala, 1052 in Tavarakere, 1892 in Adugodi UPHC, 756 in Adugodi Dispensary and 553 in Koramanagala UPHC.

IN-SERVICE EDUCATION



In-service education on soft skills for the staff of BIRDS was conducted on 28th February in the BIRDS centre. A total of 30 staff attended the programme.

MORBIDITY CLINIC



Morbidity clinic was conducted for Maralkunte residents and 65 people availed the facilities and Dr. Merlin and team from St. John's Medical college examined the patients and prescribed medicine and did referral services.

COMMUNITY HEALTH PROGRAMME





Community Health Nursing Programme and women's day programme was conducted in collaboration with BIRDS in Kadaranapura on 7th March. Nearly 500 women participated in the programme which included a Skit, Rally and a talk on women empowerment by Mrs. Joyce Meshach, Asst Professor, Dept of Community Health Nursing.

SCHOOL HEALTH PROGRAMME



School Health programme was conducted by the 4th year B.Sc nursing students in Neena English Medium School in Adugodi for children of 1st standard to 5th standard.40 beneficiaries attended the programme. Health checkup was also done for 9 teachers including the headmaster.
