## NURSING AND ALLIED HEALTH SCIENCES ADMISSION POLICIES FOR 2020-21

Because of the restrictions on travel and assembly in the context of the Covid-19 pandemic, the Entrance Test and Personal Interview, which are normally conducted in the College as part of the selection process, will **NOT** be held this year. Instead, **this year admissions to Diploma, UG, and PG Courses in Nursing and Allied Health Sciences will be based on the marks obtained by the candidates in relevant qualifying examinations. The PG courses will have a video/telephonic interview in addition.** With respect to the admission process, please note the following:

1. For all Courses, **except** Allied Health Sciences B.Sc. courses, the list of candidates selected for admission will be published on St. John's Website on the dates specified below, along with details of fee payment and other admission procedures.
2. **For Allied Health Sciences B.Sc. Courses**, the list of candidates selected for online/telephonic seat counselling will be published on the Website with details of the counselling process. After the seat counselling the candidates will receive the Admit Card with the name of the course allotted.
3. All candidates will have to pay the admission fee online within the stipulated period to confirm the admission, failing which the seat will be allotted to the next waitlisted candidate.
