

Dr. Hari Menon



Dr. Hari Menon has been in the field of medical oncology for more than two decades. He trained at the All India Institute of Medical Sciences and Tata Memorial Cancer Centre, Mumbai. He was faculty and Professor of Medical Oncology at Tata Memorial Centre Mumbai wherein he focussed in the specialized field of haematological malignancies and stem cell transplant. Besides, he also has a special interest in Neuro-oncology. In the last five years, Dr. Menon was instrumental in setting up a haemato-oncology unit in a corporate hospital until he decided to return to his passion for teaching and academia.

Dr. Menon has been a member of the Indian Council of Medical Research (ICMR) task force for formulating guidelines in haematological malignancies. He has been a teacher who has mentored fellows, post docs and post graduates in Medical Oncology. He is actively involved in clinical research and has been principal investigator in several clinical trials. He is faculty for the Australia & Asia Pacific Clinical Oncology Research Development (ACORD) as well as Collaboration for Research method Development in Oncology

workshop (CReDO), two important research methodology workshops for training researchers and oncologists in the field of clinical research.

Dr. Menon has featured consistently among the best oncologists in the country and was nominated twice as one of Mumbai's Top Docs in peer-nominated surveys. He has been credited with over 80 publications, numerous presentations at national and international meetings and book chapters. He is a reviewer for Indian and international peer-reviewed oncology journals and has been an invited member to advisory boards for drug development by multi-national pharmaceuticals. He is actively involved with patient advocacy and leukaemia/lymphoma support groups, striving to educate and ensure compliance to treatment for best outcomes and to make cancer care widely available to patients.
